**Andrew Witkin**

Boston-based artist Andrew Witkin finds inspiration in the intersection of daily life, work and relationships, often incorporating household furniture and found objects into his installations. By, say, stamping 144 white T-shirts with different, pithy phrases, Witkin puzzles over themes like personal fulfillment versus social responsibility. The effect is cumulative, in that it gathers a lot of bits and pieces together, and collaborative, in that he sometimes invites musicians to perform in his spaces. Not to mention, he's a visiting lecturer at Harvard and won the ICA's 2008 James and Audrey Foster Prize. In his art, small subjects meet big vision.
